# SENATE BILL No. 1346 

INTRODUCED BY ULIANA, HECKLER AND TOMLINSON, DECEMBER 14, 1995

SENATOR GERLACH, INTERGOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS, RE-REPORTED AS AMENDED, MARCH 26, 1996

## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 8, 1919 (P.L.148, No.102), entitled "An act providing for the joint acquisition and maintenance by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New Jersey of certain toll-bridges over the Delaware River," adding members of the commission.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of the act of May 8, 1919 (P.L.148, No.102), entitled "An act providing for the joint acquisition and maintenance by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New Jersey of certain toll-bridges over the Delaware River," amended February 26, 1925 (P.L.3, No.2), is amended to read:

Section 2. [The Auditor General, State Treasurer, and Secretary of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and two citizens of the Commonwealth to be appointed by the Governor, $]$ (a) The State Treasurer, the Secretary of AND THREE public members, none of whom shall serve concurrently

in an elected Federal or State office, who shall be nominated
APPOINTED by the Governor and subject to confirmation by a
majority of the members elected to the senate are hereby
constituted a commission to act in conjunction with a similar
commission of the State of New Jersey, as a joint commission for
the acquisition of the various toll-bridges over the Delaware
River between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of
New Jersey.
    (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, no
member of the commission shall be deemed to have forfeited nor
shall forfeit the membex's office or employment or any benefits
or emolument thereof by reason of the member's service as an ex
officio member of the commission.
    Section 2. This act shall apply upon the enactment into law
by the State of New Jersey of legislation adding two members
from the State of New Jersey to the commission, but if the State
of New Jersey has already enacted such legislation, this act
shall apply immediately.
    Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
