# SENATE BILL No. 1482 sem 1996 

INTRODUCED BY TILGHMAN, APRIL 4, 1996

REFERRED TO APPROPRIATIONS, APRIL 4, 1996

## AN ACT

Making appropriations from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry and the Department of Commerce to provide for the expenses of administering the Workers' Compensation Act, The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act and the Office of Small Business Advocate for the fiscal year July 1, 1996, to June 30, 1997, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The sum of $\$ 42,688,000$, or as much thereof as may
be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Workmen's
Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and
Industry for the payment of all salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses, for contractual services and other expenses necessary for the administration of the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, and the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566, No. 284), known as The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996, and for the payment of
bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996.

Section 2. The sum of $\$ 180,000$ is hereby appropriated from the restricted revenue account within the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Office of Small Business Advocate in the Department of Commerce as provided in the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, for the operation of the Office of Small Business Advocate.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1996, or immediately, whichever is later.
