AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for altering or
- 3 obliterating marks of identification of firearms.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6117 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6117. Altering or obliterating marks of identification.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- No person shall change, alter, remove,
- 10 or obliterate the [name of the maker, model,] manufacturer's
- 11 number[,] or other mark of identification [on] integral to the
- 12 <u>frame or receiver of</u> any firearm, rifle or shotgun.
- 13 (b) Presumption.--Possession of any firearm, rifle or
- 14 shotqun upon which any such mark integral to the frame or
- 15 <u>receiver</u> shall have been changed, altered, removed[,] or
- 16 obliterated[,] shall be prima facie evidence that the possessor
- 17 has changed, altered, removed[,] or obliterated the same.
- 18 (c) Penalty. -- A violation of this section constitutes a

- 1 <u>felony of the second degree</u>.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
