AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for 3 sentencing for murder of the first degree. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 9711(d) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 9711. Sentencing procedure for murder of the first degree. 8 * * * 9 10 (d) Aggravating circumstances. -- Aggravating circumstances shall be limited to the following: 11 12 (18) At the time of the killing the defendant was 13 14 subject to a court order restricting in any way the

defendant's behavior toward the victim pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S.

- Ch. 61 (relating to protection from abuse), or any other 1
- 2 order of a court of common pleas or of the minor judiciary
- designed in whole or in part to protect the victim from the 3
- 4 <u>defendant.</u>

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
