AN ACT

Repealing the act of June 9, 1936 (P.L.13, No.4), entitled, as 2 reenacted and amended, "An act imposing an emergency State 3 tax on liquor, as herein defined, sold by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the collection and 5 payment of such tax; and imposing duties upon the Department 6 of Revenue and the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board." The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of June 9, 1936 (P.L.13, No.4), entitled, 9 10 as reenacted and amended, "An act imposing an emergency State tax on liquor, as herein defined, sold by the Pennsylvania 11 12 Liquor Control Board; providing for the collection and payment 13 of such tax; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue 14 and the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, " reenacted and 15 amended May 29, 1951 (P.L.479, No. 112), is repealed. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 16
