AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
 - Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the crime of
- 3 stalking.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2709 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:
- 8 § 2709. Harassment and stalking.
- 9 * * *
- 10 <u>(b.1)</u> Bail.--
- 11 (1) A defendant arrested under subsection (b) shall be
- 12 afforded a preliminary arraignment by the proper issuing
- 13 authority without unnecessary delay. In no case shall the
- 14 <u>arresting officer release the defendant from custody rather</u>
- 15 than taking the defendant before the issuing authority.
- 16 (2) In determining whether to admit the defendant to

- bail, the issuing authority shall consider whether the
- 2 <u>defendant poses a real and present threat to the physical</u>
- 3 safety of the victim. If the issuing authority makes such a
- 4 <u>determination</u>, it shall require as a condition of bail that
- 5 <u>the defendant shall refrain from remaining present outside or</u>
- 6 entering the residence or household of the victim and the
- 7 <u>victim's place of employment and shall refrain from</u>
- 8 committing any further criminal conduct against the victim
- 9 <u>and shall so notify the defendant thereof at the time the</u>
- 10 <u>defendant is admitted to bail. Such condition shall expire at</u>
- the time of the preliminary hearing or upon the entry or the
- denial of the protection of abuse order by the court,
- whichever occurs first. A violation of this condition may be
- 14 punishable by the revocation of any form of pretrial release
- or the forfeiture of bail and the issuance of a bench warrant
- for the defendant's arrest or remanding him to custody or a
- 17 modification of the terms of the bail. The defendant shall be
- 18 provided a hearing on this matter.
- 19 (b.2) Mental health, DRUG AND ALCOHOL evaluation.--The court
- 20 shall order a defendant convicted of stalking to undergo a
- 21 mental health evaluation AND A DRUG AND ALCOHOL EVALUATION.

- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
