## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing for overtaking and passing of streetcars.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 3315. Passing and overtaking streetcars.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision in
- 9 this subchapter, the driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and
- 10 pass to the left of a streetcar proceeding in the same
- 11 direction, whether actually in motion or temporarily halted to
- 12 receive or discharge passengers, if overtaking or passing
- 13 requires driving in a lane normally used by traffic moving in
- 14 the opposite direction.
- 15 (b) Passenger safety.--
- 16 <u>(1) The driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and pass</u>
- 17 <u>a streetcar which has stopped to receive or discharge</u>

- 1 passengers on the side which the passengers board or alight
- 2 <u>until the doors of the streetcar are closed and the</u>
- 3 passengers which are discharged have reached the side of the
- 4 <u>highway.</u>
- 5 (2) Where a platform or pedestrian zone exists, a
- 6 vehicle need not be brought to a full stop before passing the
- 7 <u>streetcar, but may proceed past the streetcar at a speed not</u>
- 8 greater than 35 miles per hour and with due caution for the
- 9 <u>safety of pedestrians.</u>
- 10 (c) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 11 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 12 <u>a fine of \$100.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
