AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled 2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
- 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto, "providing for assessment of tapping fees; and
- 5 further providing for contracts.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of June 24, 1931
- 9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
- 10 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is
- 11 amended by adding a clause to read:
- 12 Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first
- 13 class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners.
- 14 The board shall have power--
- 15 * * *
- 16 LXXVII. Assessment of Tapping Fees. To enact, amend and
- 17 repeal ordinances charging certain enumerated fees to property

- 1 owners who desire to or are required to connect to any water or
- 2 <u>sewer system owned or operated by a municipality THE TOWNSHIP,</u>

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- 3 or who desire to increase their usages of such systems,
- 4 including connection fees, customer facility fees and tapping
- 5 fees, in accordance with the conditions and restrictions
- 6 provided in clause (t) of subsection B of section 4 of the act
- 7 of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), known as the "Municipality
- 8 <u>Authorities Act of 1945." No municipality TOWNSHIP may charge</u> <-
- 9 any tapping, connection or other similar fee as a condition of
- 10 <u>connection to a municipally owned TOWNSHIP-OWNED sewer or water</u> <
- 11 system unless the fee is calculated as provided in the
- 12 applicable provisions of the "Municipality Authorities Act of
- 13 1945."
- 14 Section 2. Section 1802(d) of the act is amended by adding a
- 15 clause to read:
- 16 Section 1802. General Regulations Concerning Contracts.--* *
- 17 *
- 18 (d) The contracts or purchases made by the commissioners
- 19 which shall not require advertising, bidding or price
- 20 quotations, as hereinbefore provided, are as follows:
- 21 * * *
- 22 (3.1) Those for used equipment, articles, apparatus,
- 23 appliances, vehicles or parts thereof being purchased from a
- 24 public utility.

- 26 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
