## AN ACT

- Providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1997-1998. 1
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 3
- Section 1. Short title and construction. 4
- 5 Short title. -- This act shall be known and may be cited (a)
- as the Capital Budget Act of 1997-1998.
- 7 (b) Supplements. -- A reference to this act shall be deemed to
- include a reference to the supplements to this act.
- (c) Fiscal Code. -- The provisions and definitions of Article
- 10 XVI-B of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as
- The Fiscal Code, shall apply to this act to the extent they are 11
- 12 not inconsistent with this act.
- Section 2. Overall limitations on debt to be incurred for 13
- 14 capital projects.
- 15 The maximum principal amount of additional debt to be
- incurred during the 1997-1998 fiscal year, and thereafter until 16

- 1 the enactment of the 1998-1999 capital budget specifying the
- 2 maximum debt for the 1998-1999 fiscal year, for capital projects
- 3 specifically itemized in a capital budget pursuant to section
- 4 7(a)(4) of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, and
- 5 the fund to be charged with the repayment of such debt, shall,
- 6 with respect to each category of capital projects, be as
- 7 follows:

- 26 (a) Bond proceeds authorized under section 2(5) shall be
- 27 used only for projects with engineering specifications with
- 28 projected durability, as defined by the Department of
- 29 Transportation, of not less than 30 years.
- 30 (b) Bond proceeds authorized under section 2(5) shall be

- 1 used only for projects that demonstrate need and merit over
- 2 other projects and shall not be used for any project not part of
- 3 the 12 year plan or for any project which is part of the 12 year
- 4 plan and is advanced for reasons other than merit, or to match
- 5 any Federal dollars for congressional projects that do not meet
- 6 the same standards for need and merit as noncongressional

- 10 This act shall take effect July 1, 1997, or immediately,
- 11 whichever is later.
