AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 10, 1968 (P.L.1158, No.365), 2 entitled "An act creating and establishing the Legislative 3 Data Processing Committee: providing for its membership;
- prescribing its powers, functions and duties; and making an appropriation, providing for access to computer information
- 6 systems by persons outside the General Assembly.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of December 10, 1968
- 10 (P.L.1158, No.365), entitled "An act creating and establishing
- 11 the Legislative Data Processing Committee: providing for its
- 12 membership; prescribing its powers, functions and duties; and
- 13 making an appropriation," is amended to read:
- 14 Section 2. The committee shall have the following powers and
- 15 duties:
- 16 (1) To establish and operate a legislative data processing
- 17 center incorporating a system or systems which will be capable

- 1 of storing and retrieving all of the financial, factual,
- 2 procedural and legal information necessary to serve all of the
- 3 committees, officers and agencies of the General Assembly.
- 4 (2) To provide access to computer information systems
- 5 operated by the committee to persons outside the General
- 6 Assembly as the committee deems appropriate. Such access will be
- 7 provided in the manner approved by the committee. No information
- 8 residing in the computer information systems operated by the
- 9 <u>committee shall be released or disseminated to persons outside</u>
- 10 <u>the General Assembly without the approval of:</u>
- 11 (i) The legislative service agency or office which
- 12 <u>originated</u>, <u>prepared</u>, <u>generated or maintains the information in</u>
- 13 <u>the form released or disseminated regardless of the source of</u>
- 14 the information. This information includes, but is not limited
- 15 to, constitutions, statutes, bills or other documents subject to
- 16 action by the General Assembly, legislative histories, calendars
- 17 and journals, rules and regulations of the executive branch and
- 18 reports or other publications of the legislative service agency
- 19 or office.
- 20 (ii) The Senate Committee on Management Operations if the
- 21 <u>information was originated, prepared, generated or maintained in</u>
- 22 <u>whole or in part by the Senate and is not subject to</u>
- 23 subparagraph (i).
- 24 <u>(iii) The Bi partisan Management Committee of the House of</u>
- 25 Representatives if the information was originated, prepared,
- 26 generated or maintained in whole or in part by the House of
- 27 Representatives and is not subject to subparagraph (i).
- 28 (2) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON MANAGEMENT
- 29 OPERATIONS AND THE BI-PARTISAN MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE
- 30 OF REPRESENTATIVES, TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO LEGISLATIVE INFORMATION

- 1 WITHIN THE COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS OPERATED BY THE
- 2 COMMITTEE TO PERSONS OUTSIDE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS THE
- 3 COMMITTEE DEEMS APPROPRIATE. SUCH ACCESS WILL BE PROVIDED IN THE
- 4 MANNER APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE, THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON
- 5 MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS AND THE BI-PARTISAN MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
- 6 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. NO INFORMATION RESIDING IN THE
- 7 COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS OPERATED BY THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE
- 8 RELEASED OR DISSEMINATED BY THE COMMITTEE OR ITS EMPLOYES TO
- 9 PERSONS OUTSIDE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF:
- 10 (I) THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS IF THE
- 11 DOCUMENT OR INFORMATION WAS ORIGINATED, PREPARED, GENERATED OR
- 12 MAINTAINED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE SENATE.
- 13 (II) THE BI-PARTISAN MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF
- 14 REPRESENTATIVES IF THE DOCUMENT OR INFORMATION WAS ORIGINATED,
- 15 PREPARED, GENERATED OR MAINTAINED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE
- 16 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.
- 17 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (2), TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO
- 18 INFORMATION RELATING TO BILLS, LEGISLATIVE HISTORIES AND SESSION
- 19 CALENDARS TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE, THE HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS AND
- 20 SUCH OTHER OFFICES WITHIN STATE GOVERNMENT AS THE COMMITTEE,
- 21 <u>WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON MANAGEMENT</u>
- 22 OPERATIONS AND THE BI-PARTISAN MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE
- 23 OF REPRESENTATIVES, SHALL DETERMINE.
- [(2)] $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ To appoint and employ an executive director,

- 25 who shall be the chief executive officer of the committee, and
- 26 such other personnel as the committee may deem necessary in the
- 27 performance of its duties and to fix the compensation of such
- 28 executive director and other personnel.
- [(3)] $\frac{(4)}{(5)}$ To enter into contracts for the services of
- 30 such professional, expert or technical services as the committee

- 1 may deem necessary in the performance of its duties.
- 2 $[(4)] \frac{(5)}{(6)}$ To purchase or rent such equipment and
- 3 supplies as the committee may deem necessary in the performance
- 4 of its duties.
- 5 $[(5)] \frac{(6)}{(7)}$ To select its own chairman, vice-chairman and <—

- 6 such other officers as the committee may deem necessary in the
- 7 performance of its duties.
- 8 $[(6)] \frac{(7)}{(8)}$ To make such rules and regulations as the
- 9 committee may deem necessary to properly carry out the purpose
- 10 of the most efficient use of a legislative data processing
- 11 system.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
