Section 8542(b) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 6 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 8542. Exceptions to governmental immunity. 8 9 10 (b) Acts which may impose liability. -- The following acts by 11 a local agency or any of its employees may result in the imposition of liability on a local agency: 12 13 14 (9) Public schools. -- A dangerous condition on the 15 premises or grounds of a public school caused by a student 16 who has a history of violent behavior, including, but not limited to, the infliction of serious bodily injury to the 17

personnel or other students of the school, except that the

- 1 claimant to recover must establish that the dangerous
- condition created a reasonably foreseeable risk of the kind 2
- 3 of injury which was incurred and that the local agency had
- 4 actual notice or could reasonably be charged with notice
- 5 under the circumstances of the dangerous condition at a
- 6 sufficient time prior to the event to have taken measures to
- 7 protect against the dangerous condition.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
