AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " providing for the denial of 21 State permits, variances, licenses or other approvals if the 22 applicant is delinquent on taxes or is in violation of 23 certain codes.
- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 27 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a

- 2 <u>Section 502.1. State Permit or License Denial.--All</u>
- 3 <u>departments</u>, boards and commissions shall deny issuing to any
- 4 applicant for same, any State permit, variance, license or State
- 5 approval for contemplated action requiring such approval; if the
- 6 applicant owns any real property in any municipality in this
- 7 Commonwealth which is tax delinquent or in violation of any
- 8 State or municipal housing, building, property maintenance or
- 9 fire safety code requirements. All State variances, approvals,
- 10 permits or licenses shall be withheld by the Commonwealth until
- 11 <u>such time as the applicant can satisfactorily demonstrate that</u>
- 12 <u>all real property owned by the applicant in this Commonwealth is</u>
- 13 in full compliance with all State and municipal housing,
- 14 building, property maintenance or fire safety code requirements
- 15 <u>and is not tax delinquent.</u>
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
