AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for application for
- 3 marriage license.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1302 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1302. Application for license.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- No marriage license shall be issued
- 10 except upon written and verified application made by both of the
- 11 parties intending to marry.
- 12 (b) Contents.--The application shall contain the following:
- 13 (1) The full name of the applicants.
- 14 (2) The occupation, birthplace, residence and age of the
- 15 applicants.
- 16 (3) Whether the marriage contemplated is the first,
- second or other marriage of an applicant.

- 1 (4) A statement that neither of the applicants is 2 afflicted with transmissible disease.
- 3 (5) The full name, residence, occupation and birthplace 4 of the parents of each applicant, including the maiden name 5 of the mother of each applicant.
- 6 (6) Any other facts necessary to determine whether a legal impediment to the proposed marriage exists.

(7) A statement that reads:

9 The laws of this Commonwealth affirm your right to enter into this marriage and at the same time to live 10 within the marriage free from violence and abuse. 11 12 Neither of you is the property of another. Physical 13 abuse, sexual abuse and assault of a spouse or other 14 family member as well as other provisions of the criminal laws of this Commonwealth are applicable to 15 16 spouses and other family members and violations thereof are punishable by law. 17

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
