AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for duties of apportionment commission.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 3109-C(g) of the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, added May 2, 1997 (P.L.149, No.12), is amended to read:

Section 3109-C. Apportionment Commission.--* * *
(g) The commission shall complete the apportionment within [one hundred twenty (120) days] one hundred eighty (180) days of certification of electoral approval of the charter. The final apportionment shall require an affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the commission.
