A RESOLUTION

1	Amending House Rule 43.
2	RESOLVED, That House Rule 43 be amended to read:
3	RULE 43
4	Standing Committees and Subcommittees
5	The Committee on Committees shall consist of the Speaker and
6	15 members of the House, ten of whom shall be members of the
7	majority party and five of whom shall be members of the minority
8	party, whose duty shall be to recommend to the House the names
9	of members who are to serve on the standing committees of the
10	House.
11	The Speaker shall appoint the chairman and vice-chairman of
12	each standing committee when such standing committee has no
13	standing subcommittees as prescribed herein, except the
14	Committee on Appropriations which shall also have a vice-
15	chairman appointed by the Speaker; when the standing committee
16	has standing subcommittees the Speaker shall appoint a

subcommittee chairman for each standing subcommittee. The

- 1 Speaker shall appoint a secretary for each standing committee.
- 2 The Minority Leader shall appoint the minority chairman and
- 3 minority vice-chairman of each standing committee and the
- 4 minority subcommittee chairman for each standing subcommittee. A
- 5 committee chairman appointed by the Speaker must be approved by
- 6 <u>a secret ballot vote by a vote of the majority of the majority</u>
- 7 members of the committee. If the committee chairman appointed
- 8 fails to receive approval, the Speaker shall appoint a new
- 9 committee chairman. A minority chairman appointed by the
- 10 Minority Leader must be approved by a secret ballot vote by a
- 11 vote of the majority of the minority members of the committee.
- 12 If the minority chairman fails to receive approval, the Minority
- 13 <u>Leader shall appoint a new minority chairman.</u>
- 14 The Speaker of the House, Floor Leader of the majority party
- 15 and the Floor Leader of the minority party shall be ex-officio
- 16 members of all standing committees, without the right to vote
- 17 and they shall be excluded from any limitation as to the number
- 18 of members on the committees or in counting a quorum.
- 19 Twenty-two standing committees of the House, each to consist
- 20 of 24 members except the Committee on Appropriations, which
- 21 shall consist of 32 members, are hereby created. In addition,
- 22 there is hereby created 34 standing subcommittees.
- 23 All standing committees shall consist of 14 members of the
- 24 majority party and ten members of the minority party, except the
- 25 Committee on Appropriations which shall consist of 20 members of
- 26 the majority party and 12 members of the minority party. The
- 27 quorum for each of the standing committees and subcommittees
- 28 shall be no less than the majority of said committees. The
