## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of October 6 through 10, 1997, as
  - "Southwestern Pennsylvania Manufacturers Week" in
- 3 Pennsylvania.

- 4 WHEREAS, Manufacturing remains the lifeblood of southwestern
- 5 Pennsylvania's economy, employing more than 1,017,000 people in
- 6 the counties of Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Bedford, Butler,
- 7 Cambria, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Lawrence, Somerset,
- 8 Washington and Westmoreland; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Manufacturing provides one of every seven jobs for
- 10 workers, ranking ahead of health care, construction, financial
- 11 services, education, transportation and government in total
- 12 employment in the region; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Local manufacturers support a total annual payroll
- 14 of nearly \$6 billion, the highest of all employment sectors, and
- 15 contribute nearly \$200 million in State, county and local taxes
- 16 to help support communities, schools and ways of life in the 13-
- 17 county area; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The exportation of manufactured goods produced in

- 1 the region brings millions of dollars to the regional economy
- 2 each year; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Manufacturing is a great career choice for the
- 4 region's youth, with an array of opportunities and an industry
- 5 average wage that is 40% higher than the average wage for all
- 6 employees in the region; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The future of the regional economy depends on local
- 8 schools to educate and prepare students to become successful
- 9 employees and managers in the manufacturing sector; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Local community leaders, educators and manufacturers
- 11 have bound together to build partnerships to strengthen the ties
- 12 between education and industry; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Pittsburgh High Technology Council's Advanced
- 14 Manufacturing Network, in partnership with the Southwestern
- 15 Pennsylvania Industrial Resource Center's The Southwestern
- 16 Pennsylvania Connection, is committed to supporting the needs of
- 17 manufacturers throughout the region; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, in recognition
- 19 of the important contribution manufacturers have made to the
- 20 economic health and welfare of the southwestern Pennsylvania
- 21 region and this Commonwealth, designate the week of October 6
- 22 through 10, 1997, as "Southwestern Pennsylvania Manufacturers
- 23 Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That all organizations and citizens in this
- 25 Commonwealth be encouraged to honor and recognize the
- 26 contributions of local manufacturers in their communities.
