A RESOLUTION

1 Declaring the month of May 1998 as "Older Pennsylvanians Month"
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, May has traditionally been recognized as "Older
4 Americans Month" in the United States, a month set aside both to
5 consider the special and continuing needs of our older citizens
6 and to alert them to the existence of services and benefits
7 already available to them; and

8 WHEREAS, This special month is also an appropriate time to
9 recognize that older citizens possess a wealth of experience,

1 talent and wisdom and a willingness to share them; and

2 WHEREAS, Older citizens highly value their freedom and
3 independence and want to remain in their homes and communities
4 as active and contributing citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, Over the past several years during the month of May,
6 such groups as the American Association of Retired Persons and
7 the Pennsylvania Council on Aging have provided programs
8 designed to educate the general public about the special
9 housing, health care and income security needs of the 1.8
10 million Pennsylvanians who are 65 years of age or older; and

11 WHEREAS, "Older Pennsylvanians Month" is also an appropriate
12 time to inform older citizens of programs already available to
13 them, including, but not limited to, PACE, PACENET, the Property
14 Tax and Rent Rebate Program, the Fixed Route and Shared Ride
15 Transportation Program and various programs and services
16 provided through the local area agencies on aging; therefore be

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare the month
19 of May 1998 as "Older Pennsylvanians Month" in Pennsylvania.
