## A RESOLUTION

1 Declaring May 1, 1998, as "Youth Action for Diversity Day" in  
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The need for breaking down racism, prejudice and  
4 stereotypes is a pressing issue facing young people today; and

5 WHEREAS, Young people want to bring about a unified, peaceful  
6 community in which to grow and become active, participating  
7 adults; and

8 WHEREAS, Young people are to be commended and supported in  
9 their efforts to break down the walls of racism and prejudice;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, Only through increased awareness of our nation's  
12 rich cultural diversity can our youth work toward eliminating  
13 prejudice; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare May 1,  
15 1998, as "Youth Action for Diversity Day" in Pennsylvania and  
16 take great pride in the youth of our Commonwealth who are  
17 committed to leading Pennsylvania in breaking down prejudice and

1 achieving "One America."
