AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery 4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes 6 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," 7 further defining "income" for pharmaceutical assistance to 8 exclude certain veteran disability payments. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. The definition of "income" in section 502 of the 11
- act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State
- 13 Lottery Law, added November 21, 1996 (P.L.741, No.134), is
- 14 amended to read:
- 15 Section 502. Definitions.
- 16 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 17 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 18 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19
- 20 "Income." All income from whatever source derived,

- 1 including, but not limited to, salaries, wages, bonuses,
- 2 commissions, income from self-employment, alimony, support
- 3 money, cash public assistance and relief, the gross amount of
- 4 any pensions or annuities, including railroad retirement
- 5 benefits, all benefits received under the Federal Social
- 6 Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. § 301 et. seq.) (except
- 7 medical benefits), all benefits received under state
- 8 unemployment insurance laws and veterans' disability payments
- 9 (except payments of service-related disability compensation
- 10 received as a result of active service in the United States
- 11 Armed Forces or the National Guard), all interest received from
- 12 the Federal Government or any State Government, or any
- 13 instrumentality or political subdivision thereof, realized
- 14 capital gains, rentals, workmen's compensation and the gross
- 15 amount of loss of time insurance benefits, life insurance
- 16 benefits and proceeds, except the first \$5,000 of the total of
- 17 death benefits payments, and gifts of cash or property, other
- 18 than transfers by gift between members of a household, in excess
- 19 of a total value of \$300, but shall not include surplus food or
- 20 other relief in kind supplied by a government agency or property
- 21 tax rebate.
