7 AMENDING THE ACT OF MAY 6, 1997 (P.L. , NO.4A), ENTITLED "AN <—  
8 ACT TO PROVIDE FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE  
9 EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE  
10 COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT AND FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR  
11 THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1997, TO JUNE 30, 1998, FOR CERTAIN  
12 INSTITUTIONS AND ORGANIZATIONS, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS  
13 INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR  
14 ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE  
15 STATE LOTTERY FUND, THE ENERGY CONSERVATION AND ASSISTANCE  
16 FUND, THE HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RESPONSE FUND, THE STATE STORES  
17 FUND, THE MILK MARKETING FUND, THE HOME INVESTMENT TRUST  
18 FUND, THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATING FUND, THE BEN  
19 FRANKLIN/IRC PARTNERSHIP FUND, THE TUITION PAYMENT FUND, THE  
20 BANKING DEPARTMENT FUND AND THE FIREARM OWNERSHIP FUND TO THE  
21 EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE  
22 JUDICIAL COMPUTER SYSTEM AUGMENTATION ACCOUNT TO THE JUDICIAL  
23 DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE MOTOR LICENSE  
24 FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1997, TO JUNE 30, 1998, FOR  
25 THE PROPER OPERATION OF THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE  
26 COMMONWEALTH AND THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE AUTHORIZED TO  
27 SPEND MOTOR LICENSE FUND MONEYS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE  
28 APPROPRIATION OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIAL  
29 DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF  
30 RESTRICTED RECEIPT ACCOUNTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1997,  
31 TO JUNE 30, 1998, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS REMAINING  
32 UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1997;  
33 AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF STATE AND

FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1996, TO JUNE  
30, 1997, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING  
UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1996,"  
ADDING AND AMENDING CERTAIN FEDERAL AND STATE APPROPRIATIONS  
MADE TO CERTAIN AGENCIES WITHIN THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
hereby enacts as follows:

~~Section 1. The sum of \$25,277,000 \$29,185,000, or as much  
thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
Public School Employees' Retirement Fund to the Public School  
Employees' Retirement Board for the payment of all salaries,  
wages and other compensation and travel expenses of the  
employees and members of the Public School Employees' Retirement  
Board, for contractual services and other expenses necessary for  
the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities of  
the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1997, and for  
the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close  
of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.~~

~~Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1997, or  
immediately, whichever is later.~~

SECTION 1. SECTION 104 OF THE ACT OF MAY 6, 1997 (P.L. ,  
NO.4A), KNOWN AS THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 1997, IS

SCHOOL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT FUND TO THE HEREINAFTER NAMED  
AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE  
PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL  
EXPENSES OF THE DULY APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE

1 COMMONWEALTH, FOR FEES FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES RENDERED, FOR  
2 THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF GOODS AND SERVICES AND FOR THE PAYMENT  
3 OF ANY OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS ACT,  
4 NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTION AND  
5 ACTIVITIES AND FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR THE  
6 FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1997, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS  
7 INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR  
8 ENDING JUNE 30, 1997.
