13	(a) FeeIf a municipal police officer executes one or more
14	warrants or effectuates the payment of fines and costs by
15	attempting to execute one or more warrants, the fee for such
16	service shall be \$35 per defendant.
17	(b) PaymentThe fee shall be borne by the defendant. The
18	fee shall be collected by the county as provided by law for

court costs. Once collected, the fee shall be remitted to the
 municipal police department which provided the service.

3 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the terms
4 "municipal police officer" or "municipal police department"
5 shall include the Pennsylvania State Police where no municipal
6 police department exists.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
