AN ACT

1 Designating a section of Allegheny Avenue (SR 1013) in
2 Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania, as Roxanne H. Jones
3 Avenue; DESIGNATING ROUTE 78 IN LEBANON, BERKS, LEHIGH AND <—
4 NORTHAMPTON COUNTIES AS THE 78TH DIVISION HIGHWAY;
5 DESIGNATING A SECTION OF ROUTE 248 AS THE POW/MIA REMEMBRANCE
6 HIGHWAY; DESIGNATING A BRIDGE IN LEBANON COUNTY AS THE
7 SENATOR CLARENCE F. MANBECK BRIDGE; ~~AND~~ DESIGNATING A PORTION <—
8 OF STATE ROUTE 0094 IN YORK AND CUMBERLAND COUNTIES AS THE
9 94TH INFANTRY DIVISION MEMORIAL HIGHWAY; DESIGNATING THE <—
10 MOUNT UNION BYPASS IN HUNTINGDON COUNTY AS THE JAMES DICOSIMO
11 BYPASS; AND DESIGNATING THE BEN WEAVER BRIDGE IN CHESTER
12 COUNTY.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 ~~Section 1. That section of Allegheny Avenue (SR 1013) in~~ <—

16 SECTION 1. ROXANNE H. JONES AVENUE. <—

17 (A) DESIGNATION.--THAT SECTION OF ALLEGHENY AVENUE (SR 1013)
18 IN Philadelphia County, beginning on Ridge Avenue and ending at
19 Sedgley Avenue, is hereby designated and shall also be known as
20 Roxanne H. Jones Avenue.

1 ~~Section 2.~~ (B) SIGNS.--The Department of Transportation <—
2 shall erect and maintain road signs, which shall display the
3 name of Roxanne H. Jones Avenue, at the beginning and the end of
4 the section of the avenue designated in ~~section 1~~ SUBSECTION <—
5 (A).
6 SECTION 2. 78TH DIVISION HIGHWAY. <—
7 (A) DESIGNATION.--ROUTE 78 IN LEBANON, BERKS, LEHIGH AND
8 NORTHAMPTON COUNTIES, BEGINNING AT THE I-81 INTERCHANGE IN
9 LEBANON COUNTY AND ENDING AT THE NEW JERSEY STATE LINE, IS
10 HEREBY REDESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE 78TH DIVISION
11 HIGHWAY.
12 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
13 MAINTAIN ROAD SIGNS, WHICH SHALL DISPLAY THE NAME 78TH DIVISION
14 HIGHWAY AT THE BEGINNING AND THE END OF THE HIGHWAY DESIGNATED
15 IN SUBSECTION (A).
16 SECTION 3. POW/MIA REMEMBRANCE HIGHWAY.
17 (A) DESIGNATION.--THAT PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 248 SITUATE IN
18 CARBON COUNTY IS HEREBY DESIGNATED THE POW/MIA REMEMBRANCE
19 HIGHWAY.
20 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
21 MAINTAIN THE APPROPRIATE SIGNS TO INDICATE THIS DESIGNATION TO
22 MOTORISTS.
23 SECTION 4. SENATOR CLARENCE F. MANBECK BRIDGE.
24 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE BRIDGE OVER MONROE CREEK WHICH CARRIES
25 CAMP STRAUSS ROAD, (SR 1022, SEGMENT 50, OFFSET 0064), BETHEL
26 TOWNSHIP, LEBANON COUNTY, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE
27 KNOWN AS THE SENATOR CLARENCE F. MANBECK BRIDGE.
28 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
29 MAINTAIN SIGNS WHICH SHALL DISPLAY THE NAME OF SENATOR CLARENCE
30 F. MANBECK BRIDGE AT EACH END OF THE BRIDGE SO DESIGNATED IN

1 SUBSECTION (A).

2 SECTION 5. 94TH INFANTRY DIVISION MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

3 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 0094 FROM THE
4 PENNSYLVANIA LINE TO ITS TERMINUS IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY IS
5 DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE 94TH INFANTRY DIVISION
6 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

7 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
8 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS IDENTIFYING THE ABOVE PORTION OF ROAD
9 AS THE 94TH INFANTRY DIVISION MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

13 SECTION 6. JAMES DICOSIMO BYPASS. <—

14 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE MOUNT UNION BYPASS IN HUNTINGDON
15 COUNTY BEGINNING AT JUNIATA AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF ALLENPORT,
16 SHIRLEY TOWNSHIP, AND PROCEEDING NORTH TO THE INTERSECTION OF
17 U.S. ROUTE 22 IN WAYNE TOWNSHIP, MIFFLIN COUNTY, IS HEREBY
18 DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE JAMES DICOSIMO BYPASS.

19 (B) SIGNS.--WITHIN 60 DAYS OF COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION OF
20 THE HIGHWAY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A), THE DEPARTMENT OF
21 TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND MAINTAIN ROAD SIGNS DISPLAYING
22 THE DESIGNATION JAMES DICOSIMO BYPASS AT THE BEGINNING AND END
23 OF THE HIGHWAY.

24 SECTION 7. BEN WEAVER BRIDGE.

25 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE BRIDGE OVER AMTRAK/CONRAIL LINES WHICH
26 CARRIES LINCOLN HIGHWAY (SR 3070), IN VALLEY TOWNSHIP, JUST WEST
27 OF THE COATESVILLE CITY LINE, CHESTER COUNTY, IS HEREBY
28 DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE BEN WEAVER BRIDGE.

29 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
30 MAINTAIN SIGNS WHICH SHALL DISPLAY THE NAME OF BEN WEAVER BRIDGE

1 AT EACH END OF THE BRIDGE DESIGNATED IN SUBSECTION (A).

2 SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.

3 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS FOLLOWS:

4 (1) SECTION 5 AND THIS SECTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT
5 NOVEMBER 30, 1998.

6 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60
7 DAYS.
