AN ACT

Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for common law marriage.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1103 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 1103. Common-law marriage.
(a) Not valid.--This part [shall not be construed to change the existing law with regard to common-law] constitutes the sole legal method for contracting marriage in this Commonwealth. Common-law marriage is not recognized as valid in this Commonwealth.
(b) Other jurisdictions.--Notwithstanding subsection (a), if a right, obligation or liability under the laws of this Commonwealth depends upon whether a common-law marriage has been contracted in another jurisdiction, the law of that jurisdiction shall apply to the determination of whether the common-law
marriage has been contracted.

Section 2. The amendment of 23 Pa.C.S. § 1103 shall not apply to a common-law marriage which is valid under the laws of this Commonwealth in effect on the effective date of this act. Section 3. This act shall take effect in one year.
