A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for qualifications of Auditor General and State Treasurer.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That Article IV be amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 18.1. Qualifications of Auditor General and State Treasurer.
10	No person shall be eligible to be elected or temporarily
11	appointed to the office of Auditor General or State Treasurer
12	except a citizen of the United States who has attained 30 years
13	of age and has been an inhabitant of this Commonwealth seven
14	years immediately preceding his election, unless he has been
15	absent on the public business of the United States or of this
16	Commonwealth.

1 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 2 3 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 4 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 5 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 6 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 7 8 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

9 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 10 11 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 12 13 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 14 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 15 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 16 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 18 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 19 primary, general or municipal election occurring at least three 20 months after the proposed constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly which meets the requirements of and is in 21 conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of 22 Pennsylvania. 23
