AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for expenses of 6 members of apportionment commissions in first class A school 7 districts. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 302.1(c)(5) of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 12 amended December 20, 1983 (P.L.267, No.73), is amended to read: 13 Section 302.1. School Board in First Class A School 14 Districts; Apportionment of Seats, and Numbers, Terms, and 15 Methods for Election of School Directors in First Class A School 16 Districts.--* * * 17 (c) Apportionment. 18

(5) (i) The school district shall appropriate sufficient

- 1 funds for the compensation and expenses of members and staff
- 2 appointed by such apportionment and reapportionment commissions,
- 3 and other necessary expenses.
- 4 (ii) The members of such commissions shall be entitled to
- 5 such compensation for their services as the school district from
- 6 time to time shall determine.
- 7 (iii) Within the limits of funds appropriated by the school
- 8 district, members of the commission may be reimbursed for
- 9 training which is undertaken to maintain or improve skills
- 10 <u>necessary to discharge commission functions.</u>
