AN ACT

- Repealing the act of April 4, 1929 (P.L.163, No.158), entitled "An act providing for real estate deputy sheriffs in counties 2 3 of the first, second, and third classes; and fixing their salaries payable by said counties; and repealing section two 5 of an act, approved the twenty-fourth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred eighty-five), entitled 'An act authorizing the 7 sheriffs of the several counties of this Commonwealth to 8 appoint by deed chief deputies with power to act as sheriff 9 10 in case of and during the temporary disability of the sheriff 11 to act in person and fixing the salaries of such chief 12 deputies in counties containing more than five hundred thousand inhabitants, ' and other acts general, special or 13 14 local so far as inconsistent herewith." 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 16 17 Section 1. The act of April 4, 1929 (P.L.163, No.158), entitled "An act providing for real estate deputy sheriffs in 18 counties of the first, second, and third classes; and fixing 19

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
