- 5 <u>injunctions</u>, and shall be entitled to this relief if the court
- 6 finds a violation under subsection (a). Prior to the filing of
- 7 any complaint in equity under the provisions of this section the
- 8 moving party shall serve upon the defendant a copy of the
- 9 <u>complaint as provided for in the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil</u>
- 10 Procedure applicable to these actions. Hearings shall be
- 11 required before relief is granted under this section and notices
- 12 of the same shall be served in the manner required for the
- 13 original process with a duty imposed upon the court to hold the
- 14 hearings forthwith.
