AN ACT

- 1 Imposing certain requirements for the observance of Veterans Day 2 in public schools and institutions of higher education.
- 3 WHEREAS, Veterans Day, November 11, is a nationally
- 4 recognized holiday dedicated to honoring the many veterans of
- 5 the United States who served the nation militarily; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Most, if not all, primary and secondary schools
- 7 within this Commonwealth observe Veterans Day as a holiday; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The various Federal, State, county and municipal
- 9 governments observe Veterans Day as a holiday; and
- 10 WHEREAS, There is concern that the 14 universities comprising
- 11 the State System of Higher Education do not observe Veterans
- 12 Day, nor properly set aside ceremonies or other events to
- 13 recognize or celebrate the meaning and spirit of the holiday;
- 14 and

- 1 WHEREAS, There is concern that institutions of higher
- 2 education within this Commonwealth hosting ROTC programs on
- 3 their campuses do not readily allow or accommodate the ROTC
- 4 cadets so that the cadets may attend and participate in Veteran
- 5 Day ceremonies or functions; and
- 6 WHEREAS, There is concern that the primary and secondary
- 7 schools within this Commonwealth do not properly set aside time
- 8 to recognize the meaning, history and spirit of Veterans Day
- 9 during the course of instruction.
- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Short title.
- 13 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Veterans Day
- 14 Observance in Schools Act.
- 15 Section 2. Definitions.
- 16 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 17 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 18 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 20 Commonwealth.
- 21 "Institution of higher education." Any of the following:
- 22 (1) A community college operating under Article XIX-A of
- 23 the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the
- 24 Public School Code of 1949.
- 25 (2) A university comprising the State System of Higher
- 26 Education.
- 27 (3) The following State-related institutions:
- (i) The Pennsylvania State University.
- 29 (ii) The University of Pittsburgh.
- 30 (iii) Temple University.

- 1 (iv) Lincoln University.
- 2 (4) An institution that is designated by the
- 3 Commonwealth as State-related after the effective date of
- 4 this act.
- 5 (5) An independent institution of higher education that
- is located in and chartered by the Commonwealth, that
- 7 operates not-for-profit and that receives Federal or State
- 8 assistance, either directly or in the form of financial
- 9 assistance to students.
- 10 Section 3. Observance requirements for public schools.
- 11 Each primary and secondary public school in this
- 12 Commonwealth, regardless of whether the school is closed on
- 13 Veterans Day, shall set aside a period during the last school
- 14 day prior to November 11 each year for a moment of reflection on
- 15 the meaning, history and spirit of Veterans Day in the United
- 16 States of America. The school may conduct an assembly for all
- 17 students, hold special classroom programs, permit visitation by
- 18 veterans or conduct a moment of silence with special notice to
- 19 the student body of the significance of the moment of
- 20 reflection.
- 21 Section 4. Observation requirements for institutions of higher
- 22 education.
- 23 (a) General rule.--Each institution of higher education
- 24 shall organize a formal program or ceremony on November 11 each
- 25 year to officially observe Veterans Day. The program or ceremony
- 26 shall recognize the history, meaning or spirit of Veterans Day
- 27 and include members of patriotic or veterans-based organizations
- 28 as participants or guests of the event.
- 29 (b) Notification. -- The institution of higher education shall
- 30 provide timely notification of the program or ceremony to its

- 1 faculty, staff, student body and surrounding community and shall
- 2 submit a report to the department, with copies to the chairman
- 3 and minority chairman of the Education Committee of the Senate
- 4 and the chairman and minority chairman of the House of
- 5 Representatives, regarding the program or ceremony.
- 6 (c) Excused absences.--
- 7 (1) Each student and faculty member enrolled in an
- 8 accredited ROTC program located on any campus of an
- 9 institution of higher education and any faculty member,
- 10 administrator, student or staff person of the institution of
- 11 higher education who is on active duty in the United States
- military, its reserves or the National Guard shall be excused
- from that person's duties and assignments on Veterans Day for
- the express purpose of being able to attend or participate in
- the observance of Veterans Day with that person's unit or
- 16 corps.
- 17 (2) No such person may lose any compensation or forfeit
- any leave time from the institution of higher education for
- 19 the excuse authorized by this section.
- 20 (3) No such student may be penalized by an instructor of
- 21 the higher education for the excuse authorized by this
- 22 section and shall be permitted to take any exam, quiz or
- 23 recitation scheduled for Veterans Day on another day in
- 24 accordance with the policy of the instructor for other
- 25 excused absences.
- 26 Section 5. Regulations.
- 27 The department shall promulgate the rules and regulations
- 28 necessary for the administration of this act.
- 29 Section 6. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
