AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for utility industry
3 restructuring.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

8 CHAPTER 20

9 UTILITY INDUSTRY RESTRUCTURING

11 2001. Applicability.

12 2002. Eminent domain and land use exemptions.

13 § 2001. Applicability.

14 In addition to any other specific requirements contained in
15 this title, the provisions of this chapter shall apply to the
16 restructuring or deregulation of any public utility industry.

17 § 2002. Eminent domain and land use exemptions.

1 (a) Eminent domain.--A public utility is not empowered to
2 exercise any powers of eminent domain granted by this title, 15
3 Pa.C.S. (relating to corporations and unincorporated
4 associations) or any other statute of this Commonwealth after
5 restructuring or deregulation of that public utility industry
6 has occurred.

7 (b) Land use exemptions.--All exemptions from local land use
8 powers, ordinances and regulations, including planning and
9 zoning ordinances of political subdivisions, granted to a public
10 utility under this title, 53 Pa.C.S. (relating to municipalities
11 generally) or any other statute of this Commonwealth shall not
12 apply to a public utility after restructuring or deregulation of
13 that public utility industry has occurred.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
