AN ACT

1 Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for exemptions for food employee
3 certification.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 6510 of Title 3 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:
8 § 6510. Exemptions.

9 * * *

10 (d) Nonprofit organizations.--A food establishment managed
11 by an organization which is recognized by the Internal Revenue
12 Service as a tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of
13 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C.
14 § 501(c)(3) is exempt from this chapter.

15 (e) Food sales limit.--A food establishment which derives
16 less than 40% gross income from the sale of food is exempt from

1 this chapter.

2 (f) Mobile and temporary food establishments.--A food
3 establishment which operates at any location for a temporary
4 period of time not to exceed 14 consecutive days, regardless of
5 whether the establishment operates continuously during this
6 time, in connection with a fair, carnival, circus, public
7 exhibition or similar transitory gathering is exempt from this
8 chapter.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
