AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation to the African-American Museum in
2 Philadelphia for operating expenses.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The sum of ~~\$310,000~~ \$341,000 is hereby <—
6 appropriated to the African-American Museum, Philadelphia, for
7 the fiscal year July 1, 2000, to June 30, 2001, for operating
8 expenses, including maintenance and the purchase of apparatus,
9 supplies and equipment.

10 Section 2. Payments to the African-American Museum in
11 Philadelphia on account of the appropriation provided in section
12 1 shall be made quarterly by the Executive Director of the
13 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.

14 Section 3. The African-American Museum in Philadelphia shall
15 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be
16 required by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission or

1 the ~~majority~~ chairman or the minority chairman of the <—
2 Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the ~~majority~~ chairman <—
3 or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
4 House of Representatives.

5 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, or
6 immediately, whichever is later.
