AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Franklin Institute Science Museum 2 for maintenance expenses.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of $\frac{$662,000}{$728,000}$ is hereby
- 6 appropriated to the Franklin Institute Science Museum,
- 7 Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July 1, 2000, to June 30,
- 8 2001, for the maintenance of the institute. No part of this
- 9 appropriation shall be used in support of the institute's
- 10 research laboratories.
- 11 Section 2. Payments to the Franklin Institute Science Museum
- 12 on account of the appropriation provided in section 1 shall be
- 13 made quarterly by the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania
- 14 Historical and Museum Commission.
- 15 Section 3. The Franklin Institute Science Museum shall
- 16 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be

- 1 required by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission or
- 2 the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 3 Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the minority chairman
- 4 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 5 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, or
- 6 immediately, whichever is later.
