AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for crimes committed
3 with firearms and the defense of firearms.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Sections 6103 and 6105(i) of Title 18 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

8 § 6103. Crimes committed with firearms.

9 If any person commits or attempts to commit a crime
10 enumerated in section 6105 (relating to persons not to possess,
11 use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer firearms) when armed
12 with a firearm as defined in section 6105(i) (relating to
13 persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or
14 transfer firearms), contrary to the provisions of this
15 subchapter, that person may, in addition to the punishment
16 provided for the crime, also be punished as provided by this
17 subchapter.

18 § 6105. Persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell

1 or transfer firearms.

2 * * *

3 (i) Firearm.--As used in section 6103 (relating to crimes
4 committed with firearms) and this section only, the term
5 "firearm" shall include any weapons which are designed to or may
6 readily be converted to expel any projectile by the action of an
7 explosive or the frame or receiver of any such weapon.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
