A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee of the
2 United States Postal Service to consider and recommend to the
3 United States Postal Service Board of Governors the issue of
4 a commemorative stamp honoring veterans of the Vietnam War.

5 WHEREAS, The United States Postal Service has issued stamps
6 relating to the Vietnam War, but none honor or remember
7 surviving veterans of that war; and

8 WHEREAS, May 7, 2000, marks the 25th anniversary of the end
9 of the Vietnam War; and

10 WHEREAS, Recognition of the surviving veterans of the Vietnam
11 War can be accomplished through the issuance of a United States
12 commemorative stamp; and

13 WHEREAS, When stamps are being issued freely for such images
14 as cartoon characters and movie stars, it is appropriate to give
15 simple recognition to surviving veterans of the Vietnam War;
16 therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
18 Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee to consider and recommend to

1 the United States Postal Service Board of Governors that a
2 commemorative stamp honoring veterans of the Vietnam War be
3 issued by the United States Postal Service; and be it further
4 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
5 the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee.
