A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee of the
- 2 United States Postal Service to consider and recommend to the
- 3 United States Postal Service Board of Governors the issue of
- 4 a commemorative stamp honoring veterans of the Vietnam War.
- 5 WHEREAS, The United States Postal Service has issued stamps
- 6 relating to the Vietnam War, but none honor or remember
- 7 surviving veterans of that war; and
- 8 WHEREAS, May 7, 2000, marks the 25th anniversary of the end
- 9 of the Vietnam War; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Recognition of the surviving veterans of the Vietnam
- 11 War can be accomplished through the issuance of a United States
- 12 commemorative stamp; and
- 13 WHEREAS, When stamps are being issued freely for such images
- 14 as cartoon characters and movie stars, it is appropriate to give
- 15 simple recognition to surviving veterans of the Vietnam War;
- 16 therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
- 18 Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee to consider and recommend to

- 1 the United States Postal Service Board of Governors that a
- 2 commemorative stamp honoring veterans of the Vietnam War be
- 3 issued by the United States Postal Service; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 5 the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee.
