A RESOLUTION

1 Proclaiming April 2000, as "Lawn Care Month" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, Lawn care and gardening are enjoyable sources of
3 exercise and relaxation for many Pennsylvanians; and

4 WHEREAS, Lawns beautify our neighborhoods and play a vital
5 role in nature and the environment; and

6 WHEREAS, Scientists have long recognized and advocated the
7 environmental importance of lawn grasses; and

8 WHEREAS, Lawns cool our neighborhoods, replenish our oxygen
9 supply, purify water, prevent soil erosion and runoff rainwater,
10 filter dust and pollen from the air and absorb noise pollution;

12 WHEREAS, We, as citizens and communities, must take time to
13 recognize the important work of the members of the lawn care
14 industry whose dedicated efforts contribute to our good health

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives proclaim April
