WHEREAS, Despite these many successes, there is still a need
for permanent, loving homes for as many as 5,348 children in
this Commonwealth; and

6 WHEREAS, The many caring families that open their arms and 7 hearts to children through adoption need to be recognized and 8 honored; and

9 WHEREAS, November 2000 marks the tenth anniversary of 10 Adoption Month observances in the United States and the twenty-11 fourth anniversary of the nation's first Adoption Week; 12 therefore be it
