20	by the person, partnership, association, corporation, or partner

of a partnership, officer of an association or principal stockholder of a corporation, who or which conducted the sale upon the same premises within one year of the termination of the sale, shall constitute a violation of this act. Every day in which business is conducted within the prohibited period of one year shall constitute a separate violation of this act. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
