AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the number of judges of the courts of common pleas in certain judicial districts.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $911(a)$ of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes, amended December 15, 1998 (P.L.949,
No.126), is amended to read:
§ 911. Courts of common pleas.
(a) General rule.--There shall be one court of common pleas for each judicial district of this Commonwealth consisting of the following number of judges:
