AN ACT

1 2	Making appropriations to the Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania.	
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
4	hereby enacts as follows:	
5	Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be	
б	necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the	
7	University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 1999, to	
8	June 30, 2000, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:	
9	(1) For dental clinics\$938,000	
10	(2) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine	
11	program	
12	(3) For veterinary activities	
13	(4) For cardiovascular studies 500,000	
14	(5) For the Children's Hospital of	<-
15	Pennsylvania	
16	Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on	
17	account of the appropriations for the items provided in section	

1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the 1 basis of costs during the fiscal year and shall be conditioned 2 3 on continuing authority for inclusion on the Board of Trustees 4 of the University of Pennsylvania of a minimum of four persons who are not elected officials and who are appointed by the 5 President pro tempore of the Senate, the Minority Leader of the 6 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the 7 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives for terms of 8 9 office coterminous with that of the respective appointing 10 authority.

11 Section 3. The University of Pennsylvania shall provide 12 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by 13 the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority 14 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the 15 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations 16 Committee of the House of Representatives.

17 Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall report its 18 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and 19 20 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth 21 22 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of 23 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-Related Colleges and Universities." 24

25 Section 5. The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania 26 shall report on forms provided by the Department of Education to 27 both the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations 28 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman 29 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives 30 by September 30, 2000, on how State-appropriated funds were 19990S0740B1113 - 2 - expended for fiscal year 1999-2000 to reduce the costs to
Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to
Pennsylvania residents.

4 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999, or5 immediately, whichever is later.
