Sentencing procedure for murder of the first degree. 10 11 (d) Aggravating circumstances. -- Aggravating circumstances 12 shall be limited to the following: 13 (19) The defendant committed the killing in order to 14 collect life insurance proceeds. 15 * * * 16 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
