AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to issue a grant for the construction of the 3 National World War II Memorial in the District of Columbia. The General Assembly finds and declares as follows: 4 5 The American Battle Monuments Commission is raising funds for the construction of the National World War II Memorial in the District of Columbia as authorized by the act 8 of May 25, 1993 (Public Law 103-32, 107 Stat. 90). There were 1,321,000 residents of the Commonwealth 9 (2) 10 of Pennsylvania who served in the Armed Forces of the United 11 States during World War II. 12 It is appropriate for the Commonwealth to contribute

to the construction of the National World War II Memorial.
