## AN ACT

5	The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
6	(1) The American Battle Monuments Commission is raising
7	funds for the construction of the National World War II
8	Memorial in the District of Columbia as authorized by the act
9	of May 25, 1993 (Public Law 103-32, 107 Stat. 90).
LO	(2) There were 1,321,000 residents of the Commonwealth
L1	of Pennsylvania who served in the Armed Forces of the United
L2	States during World War II.
L3	(3) It is appropriate for the Commonwealth to contribute
L 4	to the construction of the National World War II Memorial.
L5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
L6	hereby enacts as follows:

- 7 Section 2. Effective date.
