AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for abandoned infants.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 511. Abandoned infants.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), it
- 9 is justifiable for an individual who has physical custody of an
- 10 infant less than 16 days of age to leave that infant with an
- 11 <u>emergency medical services provider.</u>
- 12 (b) Exception. -- Subsection (a) does not apply to an offense
- 13 under any of the following:
- 14 (1) Chapter 25 (relating to criminal homicide).
- 15 (2) Chapter 29 (relating to kidnapping).
- 16 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- subsection: 1
- "Emergency medical services." The services utilized in 2
- 3 responding to the needs of an individual for immediate medical
- 4 care in order to prevent loss of life or aggravation of
- physiological or psychological illness or injury. 5
- 6 "Emergency medical services provider." A person that
- 7 regularly provides emergency medical services.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
