## AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for simple assault.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 2701 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 2701. Simple assault.
8	(a) Offense definedA person is guilty of assault if he:
9	(1) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
LO	recklessly causes bodily injury to another;
L1	(2) negligently causes bodily injury to another with a
L2	deadly weapon; [or]

(3) attempts by physical menace to put another in fear
of imminent serious bodily injury[.]; or

3 (4) Knowingly, intentionally or recklessly conceals a hypodermic needle or any such similar device on his person 4 5 during the course of an arrest or any search of the person conducted by a law enforcement officer such that the 6 7 hypodermic needle, or similar device, penetrates or sticks a <u>law enforcement</u> officer. 8 (b) Grading.--Simple assault is a misdemeanor of the second 9 degree unless committed: 10 (1) in a fight or scuffle entered into by mutual 11 consent, in which case it is a misdemeanor of the third 12 13 degree; or (2) against a child under 12 years of age by an adult 21 14 years of age or older, in which case it is a misdemeanor of 15 16 the first degree.
