AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, adding definitions related to "biometrics,"
"fingerprint imaging" and "smart card technology"; and further providing for the use of smart card technology and a fingerprint image on Pennsylvania commercial and noncommercial drivers' licenses.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
§ 102. Definitions.
Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent provisions of this title which are applicable to specific provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

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"Biometrics." The science and technology for measuring and analyzing human body characteristics, including, but not limited
the pertinent information under subsections (a.1) and (a.2). Personal medical data and other information for use in an emergency may be included as a part of the license. Information other than that required to identify the licensee, the distinguishing number and the class of license issued may be included in microdata form. Except as provided in subsection (f), an applicant shall include his Social Security number on his license application[, but the Social Security number shall not be included on the license]. No driver's license shall be valid until it has been signed by the licensee.
(a.1) Visual information on license.--A driver's license issued under subsection (a) shall contain in visual format all of the following:
(1) A distinguishing number assigned by the department to the licensee.
(2) A color photograph or photographic facsimile of the
licensee.
(3) The actual name of the license in printed form.
(4) A facsimile of the signature of the licensee.
(5) The expiration date of the license.
(6) Any other information the department deems
necessary.
(a.2) Information stored on smart card.--The smart card required under this section shall be capable of storing in a secure manner all of the following information:
(1) A distinguishing number assigned by the department
to the licensee.
(2) The actual name of the licensee.
(3) The date of birth of the licensee.
(4) The residential address of the licensee.
(5) A physical description of the person, including sex,
height and eye color.
(6) A facsimile of the signature of the licensee.
(7) Social Security number.
(8) Fingerprint image.
(9) The type or general class of vehicles the licensee
is authorized to drive.
(10) Any restrictions or endorsements.
(11) The expiration date of the license.
(12) Any other information the department deems
necessary.
(b) Identification card.--The department shall, upon payment of the required fee, issue an identification card to any person who has made application therefor in such manner as the department shall prescribe or whose driver's license has been surrendered to the department because of a suspension or revocation of an operating privilege under this or any other title. The identification card shall be designed and manufactured in the same manner and of the same components as a driver's license and shall have substantially the same content as a driver's license but shall clearly indicate that it is not a driver's license. Upon failure of any person to pass any examination required under section 1514 (relating to expiration and renewal of drivers' licenses), the department shall, where appropriate, issue a complimentary identification card as an expression of gratitude for years of safe driving. The card shall only be issued upon receipt of the person's driver's license.

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Section 3. Section $1610(\mathrm{a})$ of Title 75 is amended to read:
§ 1610. Commercial driver's license.
(a) Content of license.--The commercial driver's license shall indicate "commercial driver's license" or "CDL", shall comply with the design and manufacturer's standards under section $1510(a)$ and (a.1) (relating to issuance and content of driver's license) and the smart card technology requirements under section $1510(\mathrm{a} .1)$ and (a.2) and shall include, but not be limited to, the following additional information:
(1) [The name and residential address of the person.
(2) The person's color photograph or photographic facsimile.
(3) A physical description of the person, including sex, height and eye color.
(4) Date of birth.
(5) The license number assigned by the department.
(6) The person's signature or a facsimile of that signature.
(7)] The class or type of commercial motor vehicle or vehicles which the person is authorized to drive, together with any endorsements or restrictions.

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Section 4. The Department of Transportation shall provide a schedule to phase-in the new drivers' licenses over a four-year period which follows the expiration dates for drivers' licenses issued on and after January 1, 2003.

Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
