## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for CARRYING AND EXHIBITING 3 DRIVER'S LICENSE ON DEMAND AND FOR notice of change of name or address. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section SECTIONS 1511 AND 1515 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is ARE amended to read: § 1511. CARRYING AND EXHIBITING DRIVER'S LICENSE ON DEMAND. 10 GENERAL RULE. -- EVERY LICENSEE SHALL POSSESS A DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED TO THE LICENSEE AT ALL TIMES WHEN DRIVING A MOTOR 12 VEHICLE AND SHALL EXHIBIT THE LICENSE UPON DEMAND BY A POLICE 13 OFFICER, AND WHEN REQUESTED BY THE POLICE OFFICER THE LICENSEE SHALL WRITE THE LICENSEE'S NAME IN THE PRESENCE OF THE OFFICER 14
- 16 (B) PRODUCTION TO AVOID PENALTY. -- NO PERSON SHALL BE

IN ORDER TO PROVIDE IDENTITY.

- 1 CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS SECTION OR SECTION 1501(A) (RELATING
- 2 TO DRIVERS REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED) IF THE PERSON:
- 3 (1) PRODUCES AT THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE POLICE OFFICER
- 4 WHO DEMANDED TO SEE THE PERSON'S LICENSE, WITHIN 15 DAYS OF
- 5 THE DEMAND, A DRIVER'S LICENSE VALID IN THIS COMMONWEALTH AT
- 6 THE TIME OF THE DEMAND; OR
- 7 (2) IF A CITATION HAS BEEN FILED, PRODUCES AT THE OFFICE
- 8 OF THE ISSUING AUTHORITY, WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE FILING OF THE
- 9 CITATION, A DRIVER'S LICENSE VALID IN THIS COMMONWEALTH ON
- 10 THE DATE OF THE CITATION.
- 11 (C) EXCEPTION. -- NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 12 SECTION, NO ENGINEER, CONDUCTOR, BRAKEMAN OR ANY OTHER MEMBER OF
- 13 THE CREW OF A LOCOMOTIVE OR TRAIN BEING OPERATED UPON RAILS,
- 14 INCLUDING OPERATION ON A RAILROAD CROSSING OVER A PUBLIC STREET,
- 15 ROAD OR HIGHWAY, SHALL BE REQUIRED TO EXHIBIT THEIR DRIVER'S
- 16 LICENSE UPON DEMAND BY A POLICE OFFICER IN CONNECTION WITH THE
- 17 OPERATION OF A LOCOMOTIVE OR TRAIN WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH.

- 19 <u>(a) Driver's license.--</u>Whenever any person after applying
- 20 for or receiving a driver's license moves from the address named
- 21 in the application or in the driver's license issued or when the
- 22 name of a licensee is changed such person shall, within 15 days
- 23 thereafter, notify the department [in writing] of the old and
- 24 new addresses or of such former and new names and of the number
- 25 of any license then held by the person. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE

- 26 NOTIFIED OF A CHANGE OF NAME IN WRITING.
- 27 (b) Identification card. --Whenever any person after applying
- 28 for or receiving a department-issued identification card moves
- 29 from the address named in the application or identification card
- 30 <u>issued or when the name of a cardholder is changed such person</u>

- shall, within <del>30</del> 15 days thereafter, notify the department in 1 <----
- 2 writing of the old and new addresses or of such former and new
- 3 names and of the number of any identification card then held by
- 4 the person. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF A CHANGE OF NAME <-
- 5 IN WRITING.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
