7 (c) Notice of the existence of and eligibility for the program under Article XXIII of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, 8 9 No.284), known as "The Insurance Company Law of 1921," shall be 10 prepared by, paid for and provided to each school district in 11 Pennsylvania by the Insurance Department annually, not later than the fifteenth day of August, in sufficient quantities to 12 13 provide the parent or legal guardian of every school student 14 enrolled in the district with such notice. The school district 15 shall provide such notice to the parent or quardian of each 16 student enrolled in the district during the school year.
