## AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for retirement eligibility.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
6	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
7	<u>§ 8314. Eligibility for retirement.</u>
8	(a) General ruleA member shall be entitled to receive a
9	maximum single life annuity calculated pursuant to section 8342
10	(relating to maximum single life annuity) without any reduction
11	by virtue of an effective date of retirement which is under the

1	<u>superannuation age, if he meets the requirements set forth in</u>
2	subsection (b).
3	(b) RequirementsThe entitlement provided under subsection
4	(a) shall be applicable to any eligible member, who, on or after
5	the effective date of this section:
6	(1) has credit for at least 30 eligibility points;
7	(2) terminates school service; and
8	(3) files an application for an annuity with an
9	effective date of retirement after the completion of the
10	school term but in no case earlier than May 15 nor later than
11	the ensuing July 15.
12	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, "school term"
13	either shall have the meaning assigned to it in section 102 of
14	the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public
15	School Code of 1949, as it relates to school entities, or shall
16	mean the calendar of academic terms or semesters published in
17	the catalog of an institution of higher education any of whose
18	employees is subject to membership in the retirement system.
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
