## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class
- and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and
- 4 changing the laws relating thereto, "further providing for
- 5 tax levies.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known
- 9 as the Second Class County Code, is amended by adding a section
- 10 to read:
- 11 <u>Section 1970.4. Tax Levy for Police Services.--Every county</u>
- 12 of the second class may levy an annual tax not exceeding ten
- 13 mills to support a police department which serves the county
- 14 solely, to support the county's participation in a regional
- 15 police department or to pay for the purchase of police services
- 16 for the county.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
